

CYPRUS. Salamis. Evagoras I, circa 411-374 BC. Stater. [ E u fa go ro ], (in Cypriot syllabic script) Head of bearded Herakles to right, wearing lion's skin headdress. Rev. Note: Evagoras I, the greatest king of Salamis, claimed descent from Teukros son of Telamon and half-brother of Ajax. Having failed to avenge his brother's death, Teukros was thus prevented from returning home from the Trojan war and supposedly settled in Salamis, becoming the mythical founder of the city. But Evagoras was born under the rule of the Phoenician usurpers, and according to Isokrates, was so possessed of "beauty... strength... manly courage, wisdom and justice" that "one of the princes, starting a conspiracy, slew the tyrant and attempted to arrest Evagoras, believing that he would not be able to retain the rule himself unless he should get him out of the way." First escaping to Soloi in Cilicia, then returning with a picked band of fifty men, Evagoras attacked the palace by night and established himself as ruler of the city. The king produced a substantial issue of coinage in support of Athens and to further his ambitions for the domination of Cyprus. Indeed, with Athenian aid Evagoras succeeded in extending his rule over the greater part of the island, and even conquered several cities in Phoenicia, including Tyre. Yet when Athenian support was withdrawn under the terms of the Peace of Antalkidas, Evagoras continued to fight alone against the Persian Empire, which resulted in an invasion of the island that effectively reduced him to the status of a vassal king. In 374 he was assassinated by a eunuch for motives of private revenge, and was succeeded by his son, Nikokles. The inscription on the reverse of this coin is written in a combination of Cypriot syllabic and Greek characters. Although Cypriots were Greeks and their language a dialect of Greek, their written language was recorded in an older and more difficult system, the Cypriot syllabary, which was ultimately derived from the Linear A script of the Minoans. Evagoras has been called a pioneer of the adoption of the Greek alphabet in Cyprus in place of the older Cypriot syllabary. SNG Levante 176. SNG Paris 416. Tiribazus, Tiribazos or Teribazus (c.440 BC-370 BC) was an Achaemenid satrap of Western Armenia and later satrap of Lydia in western Anatolia. Satrap of Western Armenia He was highly regarded by the Persian King Artaxerxes II, and when he was present, so Xenophon tells us, no one else had the honour of helping the sovereign to mount his horse. At the time of the retreat of the 10,000 in 401 BC, Tiribazus was satrap of Western Armenia. Satrap of Lydia He succeeded Tithraustes as satrap of Western Asia (Sardis). He was holding this office when, in 393 BC, Antalcidas was sent to negotiate, through him, a peace for Sparta with the Persian king. In 392 BC, while the Corinthian War was being contested amongst the Greek states, Tiribazus received envoys from the major belligerents of that war, and held a conference in which a proposal for ending the war was discussed. That discussion failed, but Tiribazus, convinced that Athens was becoming a threat to Persia in the Aegean, secretly provided funds to rebuild the Spartan fleet. When the Persian king Artaxerxes II learned of this, Tiribazus was removed from power and replaced by Struthas, who pursued an anti-Spartan policy. However, five years later, in 387 BC, Tiribazus was again in power, and worked together with the Spartan general Antalcidas to rebuild the Spartan fleet as a threat to Athenian interests in the region. This action brought the Athenians and their allies to the negotiating table. Tiribazus represented Artaxerxes at the ensuing negotiations, which led to the Peace of Antalcidas. In 386 BC, he was appointed to command the Persian fleet against Evagoras, the king of Salamis in Cyprus, with the land forces being entrusted to the Persian satrap of Armenia, Orontes. They defeated Evagoras and lay siege to Salamis. However, in 385 BC Tiribazus was impeached by Orontes, and was recalled to court to answer for his conduct. Tiribazus was detained in prison until the return of Artaxerxes from his expedition against the Cadusii. Before three judges, Tiribazus was able to have the charges against him dismissed, and he was honourably acquitted with the full support of King Artaxerxes, in consideration not only of his innocence in regard to the special charges, but also of the great services he had rendered to his master. Tiribazus now stood higher than ever in the royal favour, and received a promise of the hand of Amestris, the king's daughter. Artaxerxes, however, reneged on this arrangement, and married Amestris himself. When King Artaxerxes reneged on a pledge to Tiribazus once more, this time with respect to Atossa, the youngest of the king's princesses, Tiribazus could no longer remain loyal to the king and incited Darius, the son of Artaxerxes, to join him in a plot against the king's life. Tiribazus' plans were betrayed to Artaxerxes by a eunuch, and the conspirators were found out. The hereditary kings of Cilicia were invested with the name Syennesis, a royal title more than an actual name. Syennesis III was probably the grandson of Syennesis II, one of the commanders in the fleet of Xerxes. In 401 BC, he sent a body of troops commanded by his son to support the revolt of Cyrus II against his brother Artaxerxes II. Syennesis was richly rewarded with gifts and honors in return for his support. At the same time, though, he had sent his other son to Artaxerxes, so that he might be with the winning side regardless of the outcome. 

The Aramaic inscription on the reverse of this stater has prompted Biblical coin researcher David Hendin to reconsider the meaning of this coin type. It traditionally is translated as "Mazaios governor of Transeuphrates and Cilicia," but Hendin translates it somewhat differently as "Mazaios who is over Eber Nahara and Cilicia." The similarity of this inscription and a descriptive phrase used in two books of the Old Testament (which was codified at approximately the time this coin was struck) has led to Hendin's suggestion that the walls on this coin represent the ones encompassing Jerusalem, which less than a century before had been rebuilt by Nehemiah, as related in the Books of Ezra and Nehemiah. (A fuller discussion of the subject is presented on pages 100-103 of the 4th edition of Hendin's Guide to Biblical Coins.) Comments: Placed on the throne by his uncle, thecaesarJohn Doukas, after Romanos IV's defeat and capture at Mantzikert, Michael suffered by comparison with the strong figures aroundhim. A student of Michael Psellos, he appears favorably in hisChronographia, but the reign was one of economic and military disaster. Although the defeat at Mantzikert was not the military catastrophe that it was once thought to be, the resulting civil wars, accompanied by the government in Constantinople's complete inability to resist Turkish incursions, resulted in the progressive loss of Asia Minor. Economically, the reign saw a rapid and deep debasement of gold, and the reduction of the measure of wheat (modios) by a quarter (para pinakiou), which effectively raised the price of wheat by a third. These economic changes attest to the high level of inflation in the 1070s, and earned Michael the nickname "Parapinakion." Hislogothetes tou dromouNikephoritzes took over the administration of the government, and is noted in sources as being fiscally severe. Michael's unpopularity and incompetence led to a number of rebellions, most notably by Roussel de Bailleul, Nikephoros 6Bryennios, and the future emperor Nikephoros III Botaneiates, which left Michael besieged in the capital. The elderly Botaneiates was ultimately successful, and Michael abdicated and entered a monastery. Michael's seals mark a return of theautokrator, in both their inscription as well as in their depiction of the emperor full-length and alone. Family did not return to imperial seals again during the empire; lineage instead would be indicated in increasingly complex family names. Sabine 49; Metcalf, Crusades 521-2; CCS 9b., Rare. Raymond III came to power in after his father, Raymond II, was assassinated by the Hashshashin in 1152. He was the greatgrandson of Raymond IV of Toulouse, who was a leader in the First Crusade. In 1164 Raymond assisted Bohemond III of Antioch in an attempt to lift the siege the Zengid ruler Nur al-Din had placed on Harim. The Muslims were triumphant in the ensuing battle, and both crusaders were taken prisoner along with Jocelin III of Edessa and Hugh VIII de Lusignan. Raymond remained in captivity until 1173, when he was ransomed for 80,000 gold pieces. During his absence, Amalric I of Jerusalem ruled in Tripoli as regent, and relinguished control to Raymond upon the latter's release. From 1174-1176 Raymond served as bailli (regent) of Jerusalem, while King Baldwin IV was in his minority. During this time, Raymond gained control of the fortress of Tiberias by marrying Eschiva of Bures, who was the widow of Walter of Saint-Omer of Tiberias. Over the ensuing decade, dynastic intrigue led to Raymond's reappointment as bailli of Jerusalem, but his attempts to influence the succession following the death of Baldwin IV and V, failed, resulting in the crowning of his rival, Guy de Lusignan, as the new king of Jerusalem. As a result, Raymond returned to Tiberias and made peace with the new Muslim leader, Saladin, in an attempt to unite against Guy. Saladin maintained an army near Tiberias, threatening to invade the Kingdom of Jerusalem, in response to continued assaults on Muslim caravans by an ally of Guy, Raynald of Chatillon. Eventually, a peace embassy from Guy, led by Balian of Ibelin, was sent to meet with Raymond, but was ambushed and defeated by Saladin at the Battle of Cresson in May 1187. In response, Raymond reluctantly came to terms with Guy, and Saladin responded by besieging Tiberias. Raymond, who was not at Tiberias at the time, joined his forces with Guy at Acre and discussed how to proceed. Raymond desired to not force a pitched battle with Saladin, but Guy refused, and his intent on a direct attack resulted in the disastrous Battle of Hattin on July 4. The crusader forces were utterly crushed, but Raymond, who commanded the vanguard, was able to escape after his forces were cut off from the main body of the army. Raymond and the other few survivors regrouped in Tyre but decided to disperse to their respective bases. Shortly thereafter, Raymond died of Pleurisy in Tiberias. Metcalf, Crusades 361-2; CCS 58 var. (rev. legend). Bohémond was born to Raymond of Poitiers, then Prince of Antioch, and Constance of Antioch in 1144. Raymond was killed leading a Crusader army against the Zengid forces of Nur al-Din at the battle of Inab in 1149. As Bohémond was still in his minority, his mother ruled as regent. When he came of age in 1163, however, Constance attempted to retain power, but she was exiled after her subjects revolted. Bohémond was a close ally of Raymond III of Tripoli, and he joined the latter in attempting to lift Nur al-Din's siege of Harim in 1164. The venture was a failure, and both were captured and imprisoned by the Muslims. The Byzantine emperor intervened and ransomed their release the following year. Over the following two decades, Bohémond became involved in internal disputes among the Byzantines, the Armenian Kingdom, and the Kingdom of Jerusalem. Regarding the latter, he and Raymond of Tripoli attempted to have Baldwin IV of Jerusalem name their candidate, Balian of Ibelin, as heir, but the king decided upon Gui of Lusignan. This event has terrible consequences for the Crusaders. Gui and his allies sparked a conflict with the Muslims under Saladin, whose forces eventually destroyed a the Kindgom's army, which also included many allied forces, at the battle of Hattin in 1187. With this defeat, the Jerusalem soon fell to the Muslims. Bohémond was not present for the battle, but his elder son, Raymond, was there, but escaped with Raymond of Tripoli. After Hattin, Saladin moved against Antioch, but Bohémond successfully defended the city, and the Muslims were forced to withdraw. Raymond of Tripoli died soon after Hattin, and had designated Bohémond's son Raymond as his successor, but Bohémond appointed his younger son, Bohémond IV, instead. In 1194, king Leo II of Armenia captured a castle of the outskirts of Antioch, and took Bohémond captive after luring him there under the pretense of conducting negotiations. Eventually, Henri II, nominal king of Jerusalem, intervened, and secured Bohémond's release upon the latter's giving up any claim to Armenian territory. Bohémond's later years were relatively uneventful, but his death in 1201 sparked a succession battle between his son, Bohémond IV, and grandson, Raymond-Roupen.
